The past continuous tense refers to a continuing action or state that was happening at some point in the past.



-We use the past continuous tense when we want to talk about an action that was happening over a period of time in the past.

Examples:

I was reading my book last night.

He was driving when we saw him.



Positive Form

(work)

I + was + V-ing (working)

he/she/it + was + V-ing (working)

you/we/they + were + V-ing (working)

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We were waiting for you.

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I was working when you had
the car accident.

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She was studying while He
was playing video games.

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They were planning a party.

I, He, She, It, Sam (Name)	was not (wasn't) going	to school
You, We, They	were not (weren't) going	to school

Example :

iii) We were going to school.	iii) We were not going to school.
iv) They were going to school.	iv) They were not going to school.
v) He was going to school.	v) He was not going to school.
