Present continuous tense



We use the present continuous tense to describe a temporary event or situation.

Present continuous tense



We frequently use the present continuous to speak about planned future actions.

Present continuous tense



The present continuous tense is formed from the present tense of the verb "be" and the "present participle" (-ing form) of a verb.

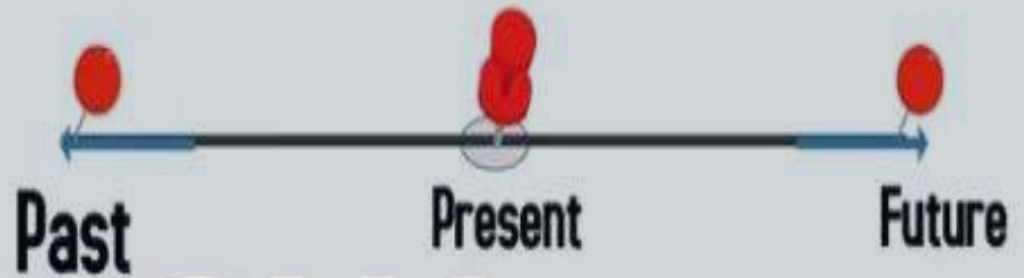

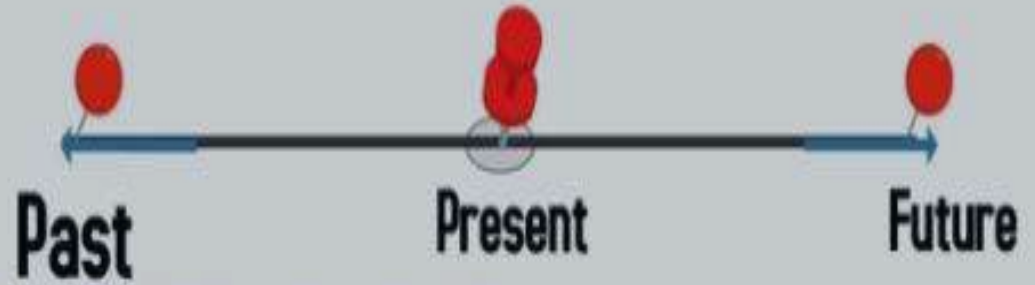
