Use of Am / is / are

- used in present tense

(Present tense used to talk about conditions happening right now)

am -> I

is -> he, she, it or any name like

Ram, Sam..

are -> you, we, they

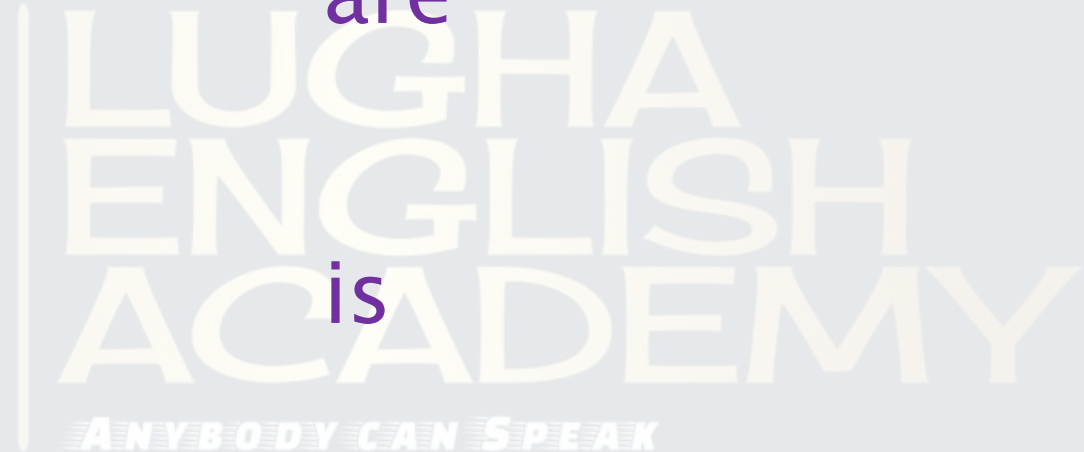
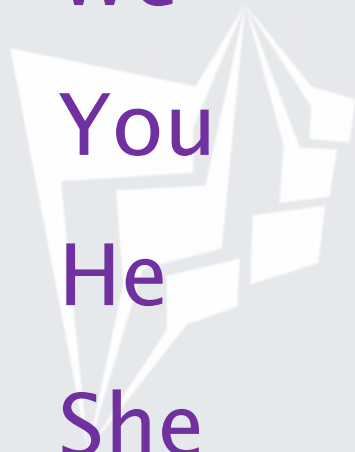

Verbs in English comes in three main categories

- The Affirmative
- The Negative
- The Interrogative

* **The Affirmative** -> asserting that something is true or valid.

* **The Negative** -> denying something.

* **The Interrogative** -> asking a question.

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I am You are He is She is It is We are They are	I am not You are not He is not She is not It is not We are not They are not	Am I? Are you? Is he? Is she? Is it? Are we? Are they?



Examples:

I am a doctor -> Affirmative

He is not a doctor -> Negative

Are you a doctor -> Interrogative

Examples using 'am' - Affirmative

- * I am Govind.
- * I am in Jaipur.
- * I am 25 yrs old.
- * I am happy.
- * I am hungry.
- * I am a tall girl.
- * I am a smart kid.
- * I am going to attend the meeting.

Examples using 'is' - Affirmative

- * He is Ravi.
- * He is in Jammu.
- * He is 40 yrs old.
- * She is Poorni.
- * She is playing.
- * She is a short girl.
- * It is hot.
- * It is raining.
- * It is my laptop.
- * Reenu is my friend.
- * Reenu is going to Madurai.
- * Reenu is a brilliant girl.

Examples using 'are' - Affirmative

- * You are intelligent.
- * You are my cousin.
- * You are doing my homework.
- * We are in India.
- * We are buying food for the needy people.
- * We are going for a trip.
- * They are students.
- * They are very busy.
- * They are collecting the books.

Examples - Interrogative

- * Am I a doctor?
- * Are you an Engineer?
- * Is he at home?
- * Is she your sister?
- * Is it a dog?
- * Are we friends?
- * Are they farmers?

Examples - Negative

- * I am not sad.
- * I am not at office.
- * You are not going for the party.
- * He is not tall.
- * She is not brilliant.
- * It is not raining.
- * Sam is not eating well.
- * They are not finishing the work.

- are also called information questions because we are trying to get some specific information from another person (not just a 'yes' or 'no' answer)

Be verbs (formula)

WH + Be + Subject

Example : Where are you from?
Who is that man?
When is your class?

Ex: Why are you doing exercise?

4. How – condition or quality of something

Ex: How are you doing?

5. What – object, idea or action

Ex: What is your job?

Ex: Which one is your book?

7. Whose – possession

Ex: Whose pen is this?

8. When – time, occasion, moment

Ex: When is your exam?
