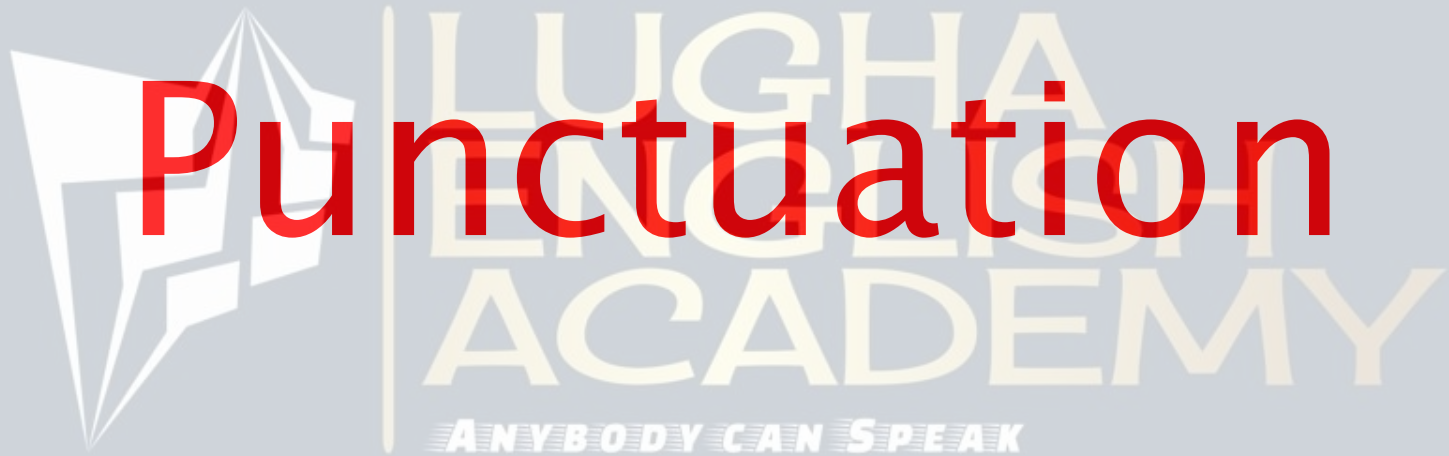

Punctuation

– using punctuation marks, we can write correct English without making mistakes.



The commonly used punctuation mark.

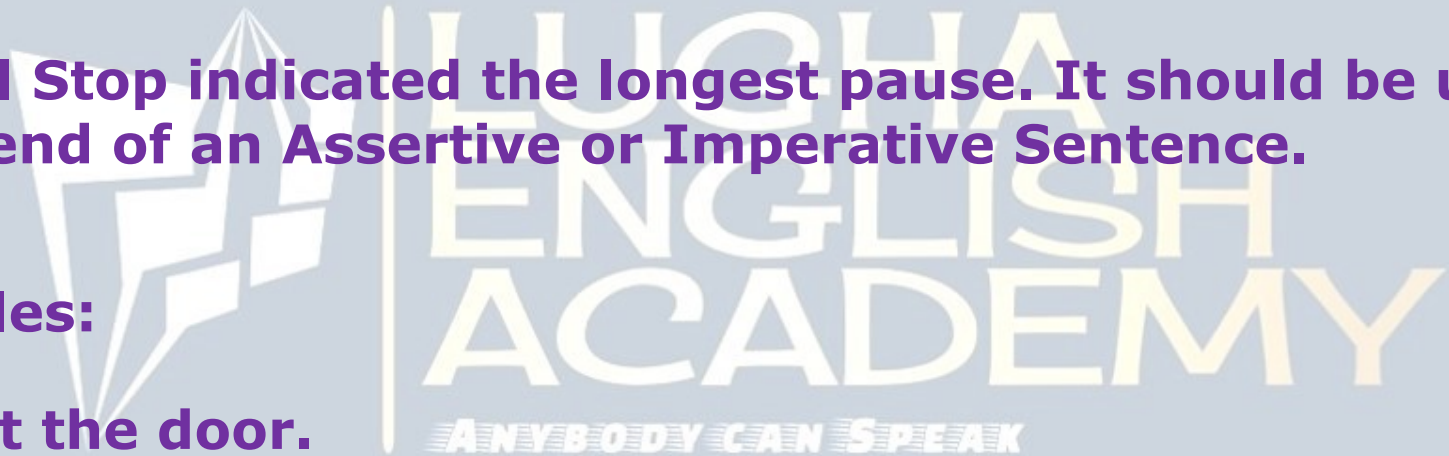
1.The full stop (.)

Period(also called as Full Stop)

The full Stop indicated the longest pause. It should be used at the end of an Assertive or Imperative Sentence.

Examples:

- Shut the door.
- Today is a beautiful day.
- Pick up the blue ball.
- Turn left at the next light.
- Hand me the pencil.



2.The Comma (,)

- The comma indicates the shortest pause in a sentence.
- separates items in a list.

Examples: –

- I like blue, green and yellow colour.
- My mother told me to buy bread, eggs, butter and sugar.
- The children laughed, danced, jumped and cried for joy.

3) Exclamation Mark (!)

The sign of exclamation is used after interjections, exclamatory phrases and sentences.

Examples:

Alas!, Bravo!, Ah!, How it rains!, Well done!

- Wow, I really love you!
- Fantastic, let's go!
- That birthday cake was so good!
- Sheldon's gift was so amazing!

Exclamatory Sentences That Begin with "What:"

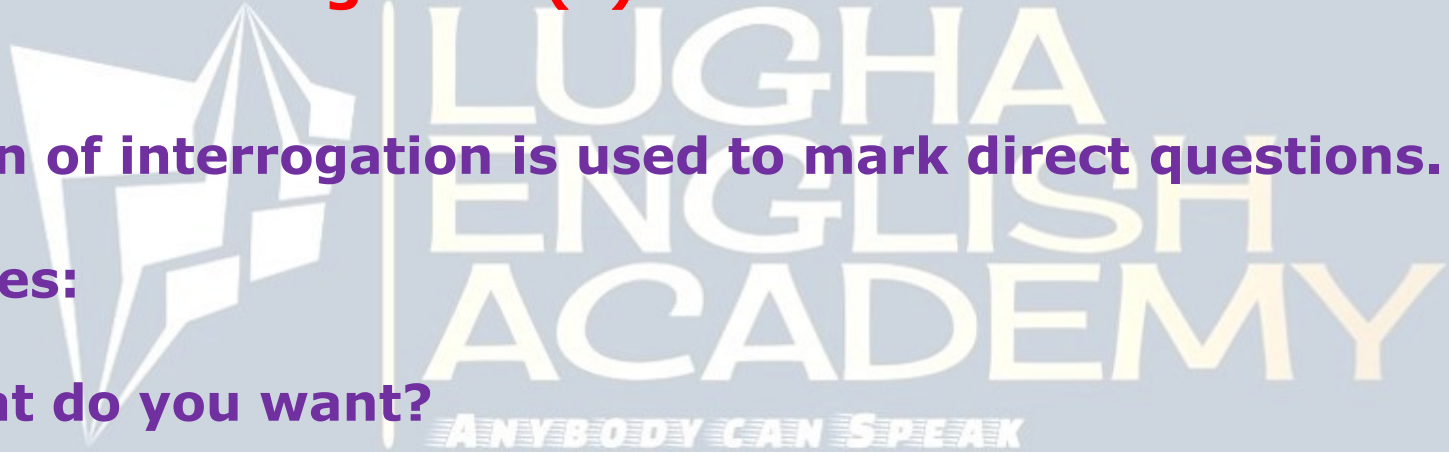
- What a lovely bouquet of flowers!
- What a cute puppy!
- What an ugly bug!
- What a happy ending!

4) Sign of Interrogation (?)

The sign of interrogation is used to mark direct questions.

Examples:

- What do you want?
- How are you?
- Would you prefer chocolate or vanilla ice cream?
- Should I call or email you?
- Do you want coffee, tea, or soda?



5)Use of Capital Letters

The capital letter is used –

- To begin a sentence.
- The first word of every line of a poem.
- To begin a proper noun.

Capitalization and Punctuation Rules

Capital Letters

Always use a capital letter for...

the first word of a sentence	Thank you for the letter.
the first word in a quotation	She said, "Today is beautiful."
the greeting and closing in a letter	Dear John Sincerely, Sherry
the names of days, months, and holidays	Thursday November Thanksgiving
people's first and last names, their initials, and their titles	Mrs. Smith and Phil were seen by Dr. Lee
the word that names yourself - I	My friend and I love horses.
the names of streets, cities, and states	Palm Avenue Mesa, Arizona
the names of specific buildings and monuments	Statue of Liberty Empire State Building
the titles of stories, movies, TV shows, video games, etc.	Night at the Museum Star Wars

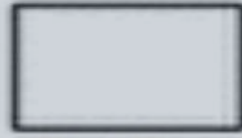

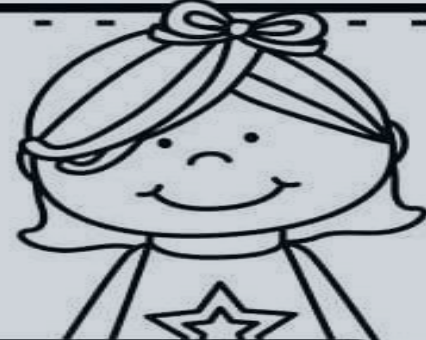
