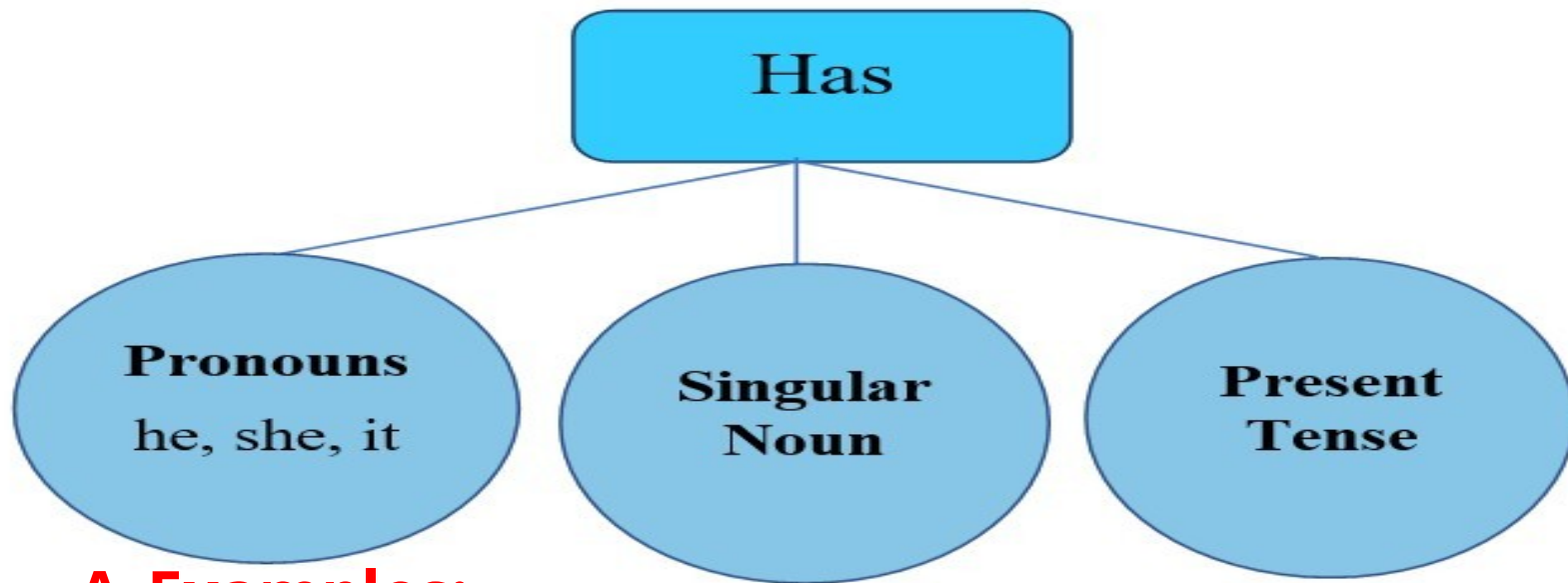


Definition of Auxiliary Verbs in English

- 'Have', 'Has' and 'Had' are referred to as auxiliary verbs.
- An auxiliary verb is the one which expresses the tense and voice of other verbs.

A. Has

- 'Has' is used with pronouns like he, she, it or singular nouns.
- It is used in sentences written in the present tense.

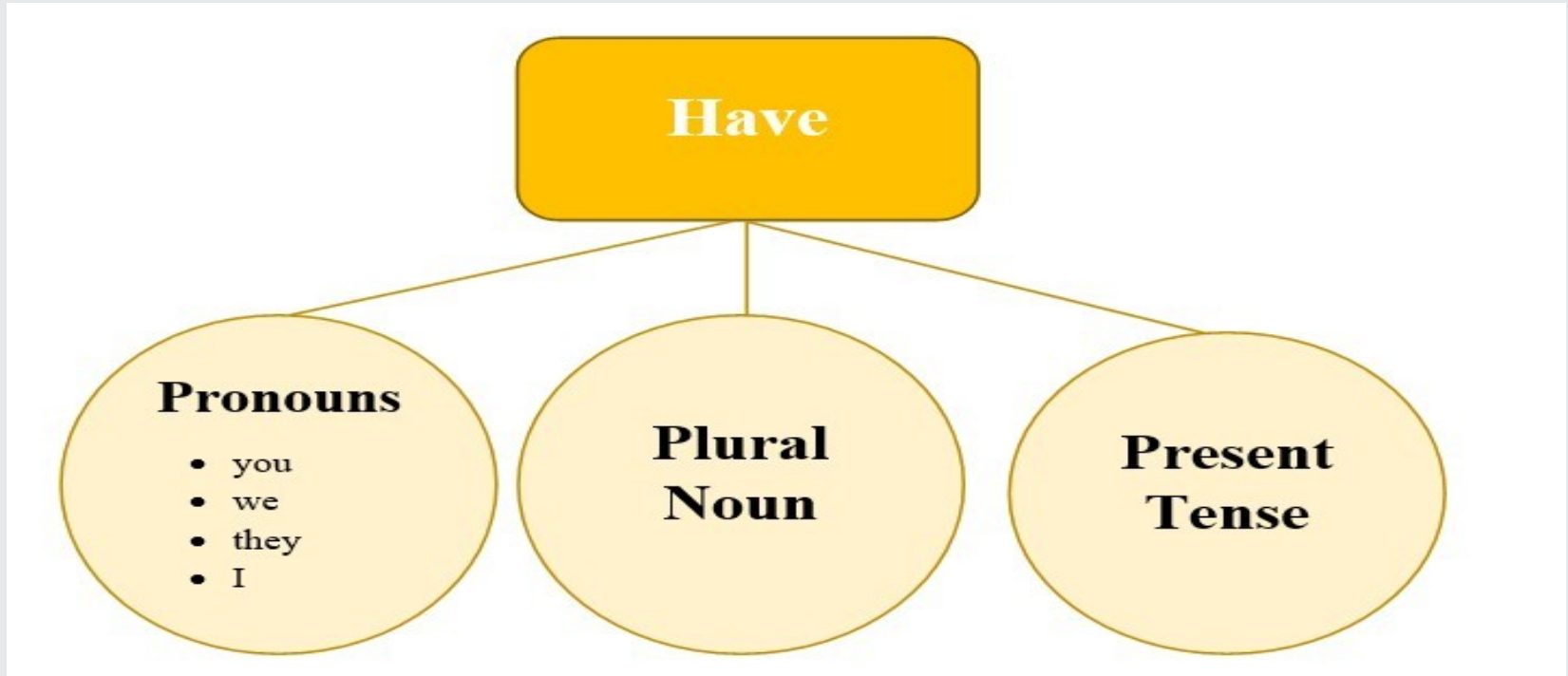


A. Examples:

- a. He **has** a red bicycle.
- b. It **has** a long tail.

A. Have

- 'Have' is used with pronouns like you, I, we, they, and plural nouns like toys, dogs, animals, people, boys, girls, etc.



EXAMPLES:

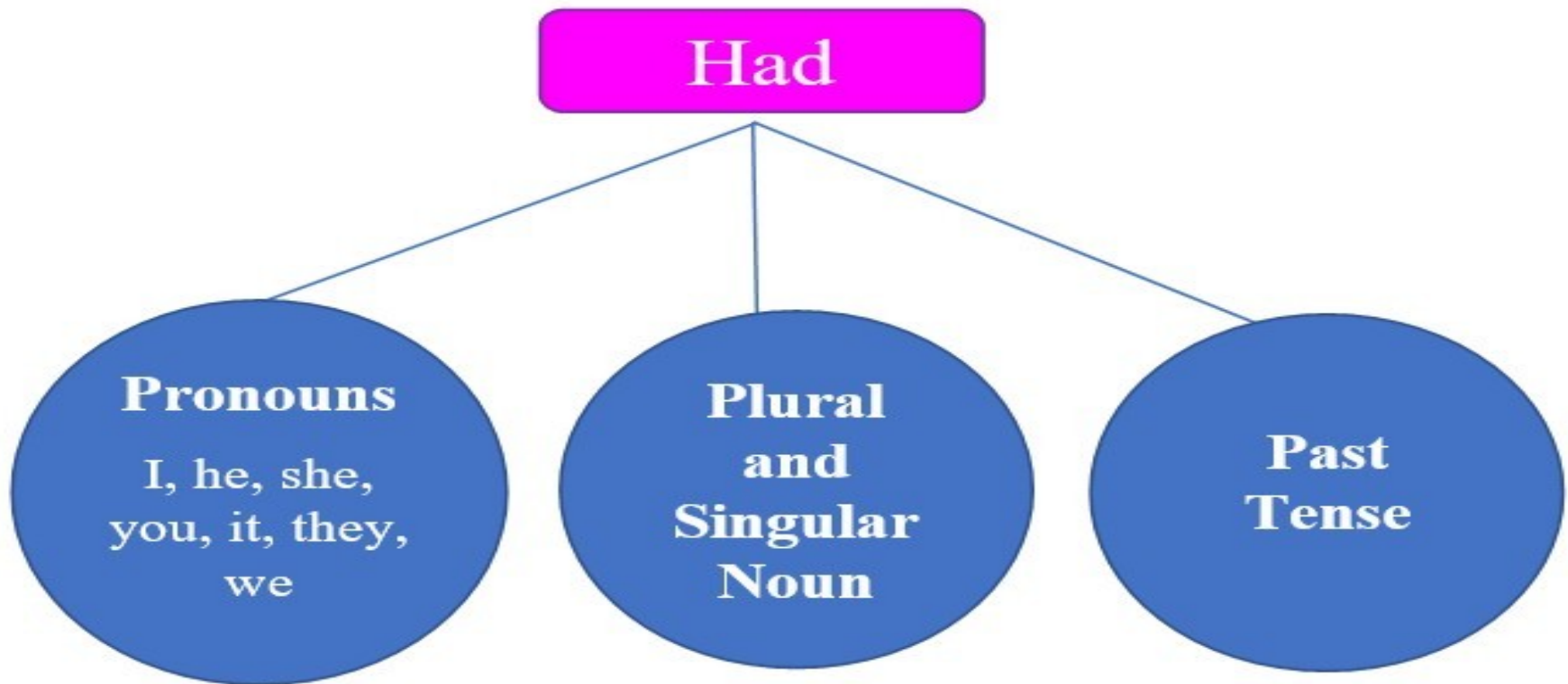
- We **have** to visit him tomorrow.
- They **have** many cars.

A. Had

B. 'Had' is used with pronouns like I, he, she, you, it, they, and we. It is also used with both singular or plural nouns in the past tense.

Examples:

1. They had chicken in the lunch.
2. I had to wait a long time to meet him.

USE OF HAS, HAD, HAVE

Has

It is used with

- He, she, it
- Singular nouns
- Present tense

Had

It is used with

- I, he, she, you,
it, they, we
- Singular or
Plural nouns
- Past tense

Have

It is used with

- 'You, I, we,
they
- Plural nouns
- Present tense
