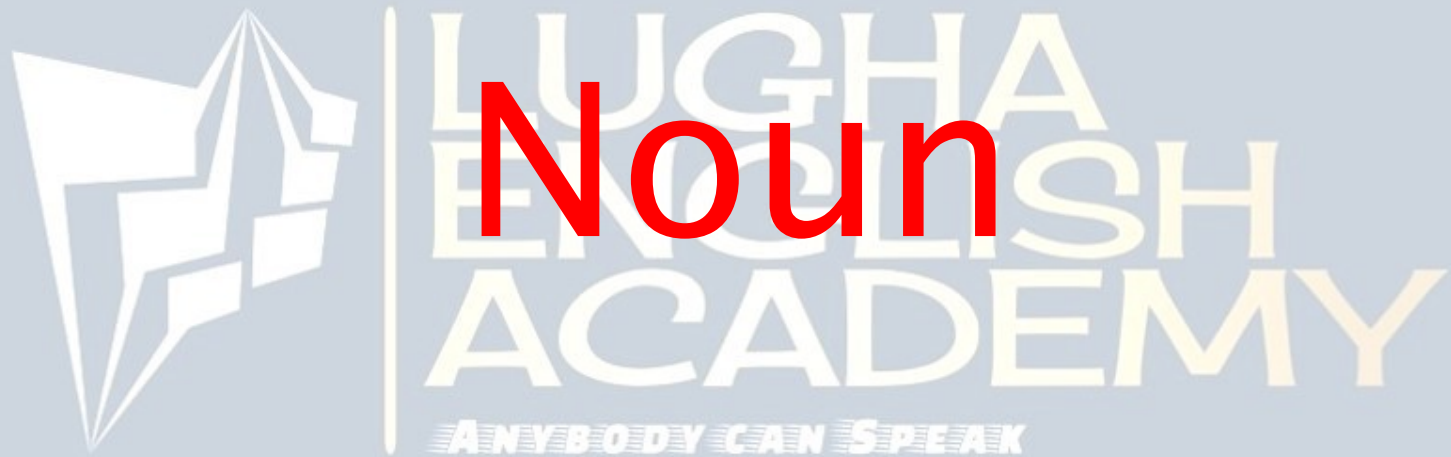

Common and proper

noun – All nouns have a common name and some nouns have a special name.

Examples:

boy – Arjun (**person**)

beach – Marina (**place**)

animal- lion (**animal**)

television - Sony (**thing**)

Common noun

– common nouns are names of persons, places, animals or things in general.

Examples:

This is a **girl**. (person)

This is a **temple**. (place)

This is my **pet**. (animal)

This is a **watch**. (thing)

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Proper noun – a special name given to a person, place, animal or a thing.

- starts with a capital letter.

- names of cities, rivers, holidays, days, months, festivals, people etc.,

Examples:

This is **Riya**. (person)

This is a **Sun** temple. (place)

This is my pet **Moti**. (animal)

This is **Titan** watch. (thing)
