- general things
- they don't point at any particular person or thing. They always suggest any person or any thing.
- they come before singular common nouns.

a, an

Indefinite Articles – a, an

a -> before the consonant sounds.

an -> before the vowel sounds.
(a, e, i, o, u)

Example:

Give **an** apple to eat.

Here, it refers the person wants any apple.

This rule applies to all words after **A** or **AN** (including adjectives, adverbs...)

Here, it refers to a particular book.

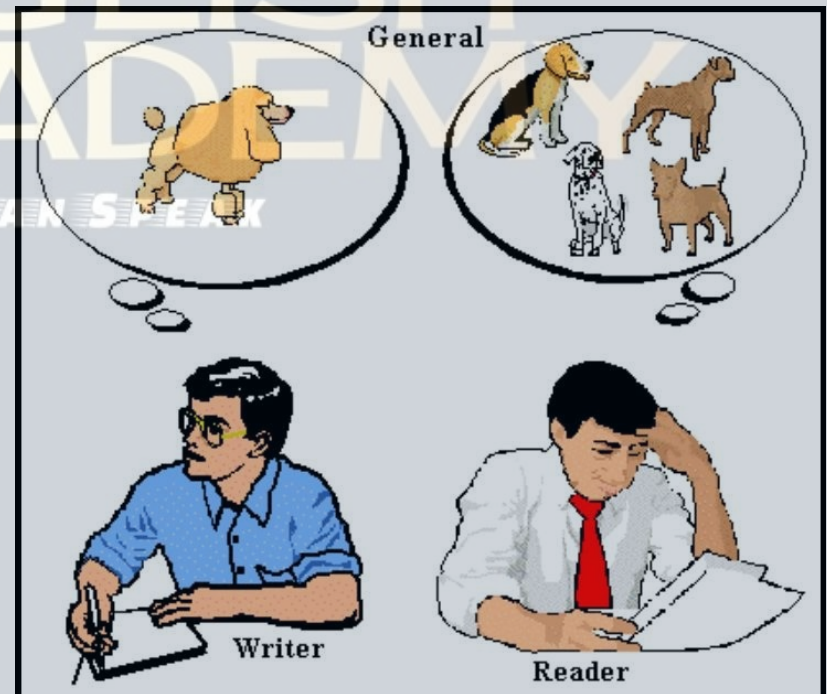
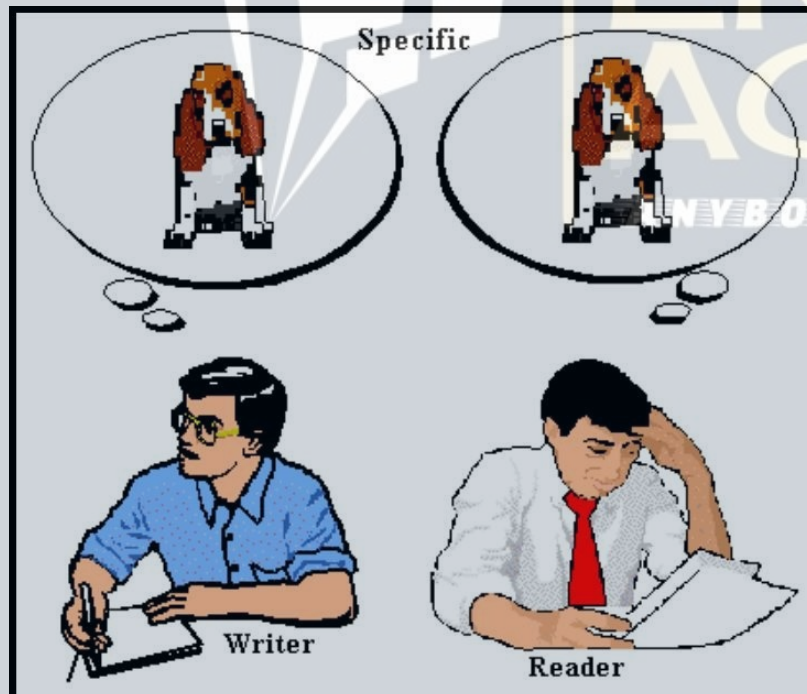
Definite Articles - the

Do you remember **the** dog we had during our childhood days?

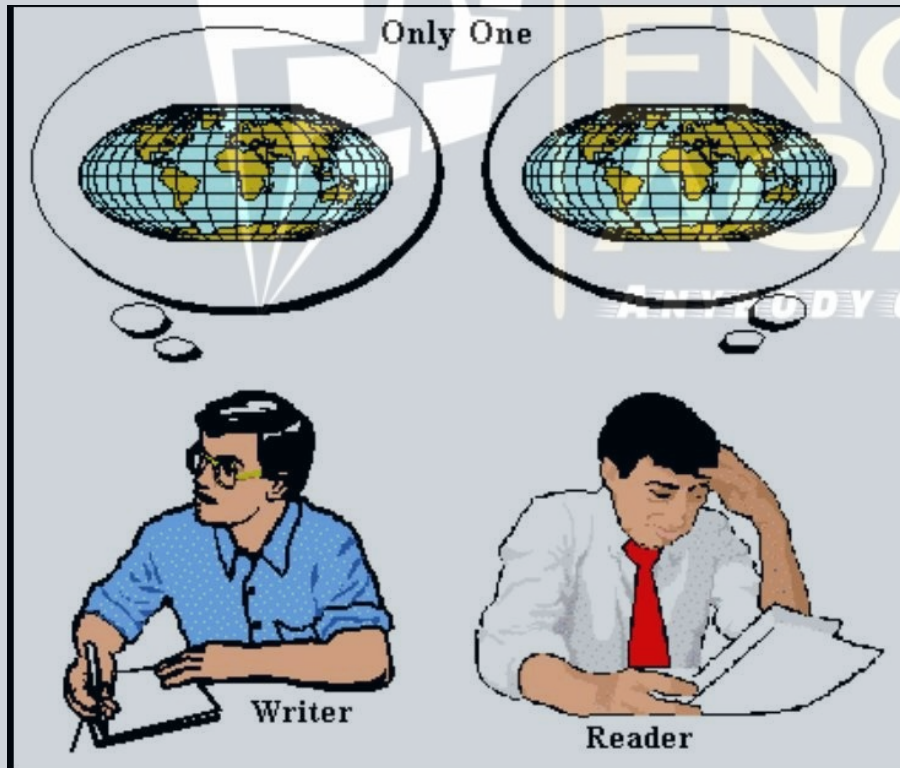
I want to buy **a** dog.

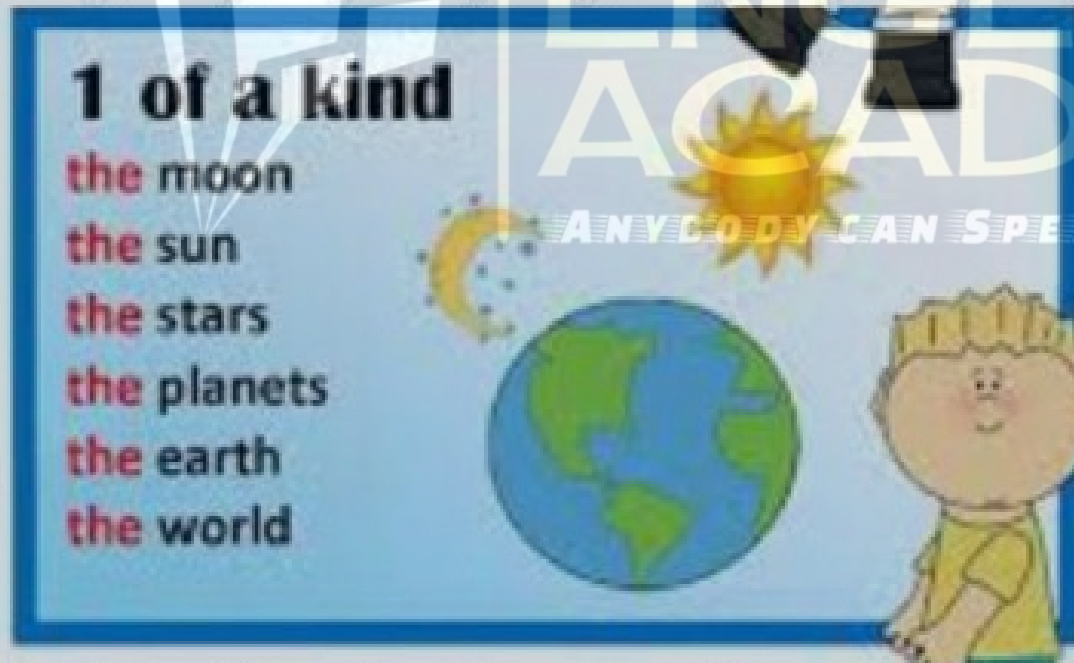

The world is a beautiful place to live.



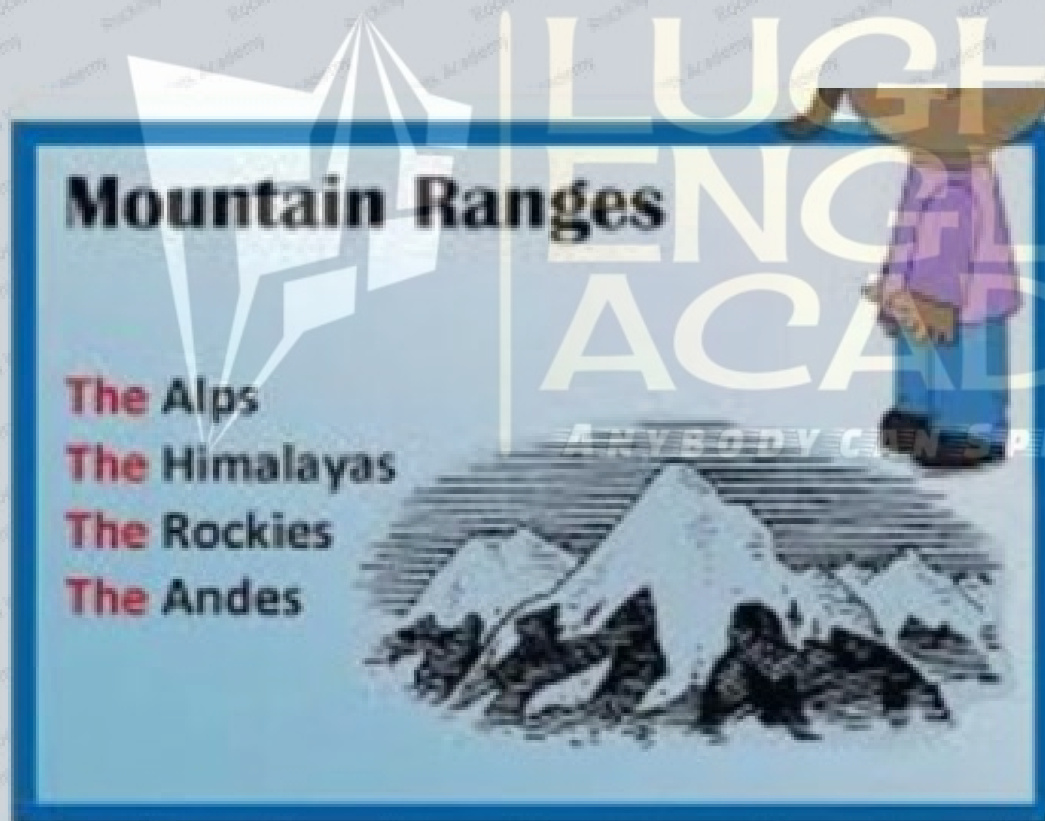
Definite Articles - the

“The” will be used when we talk about the mountain ranges.



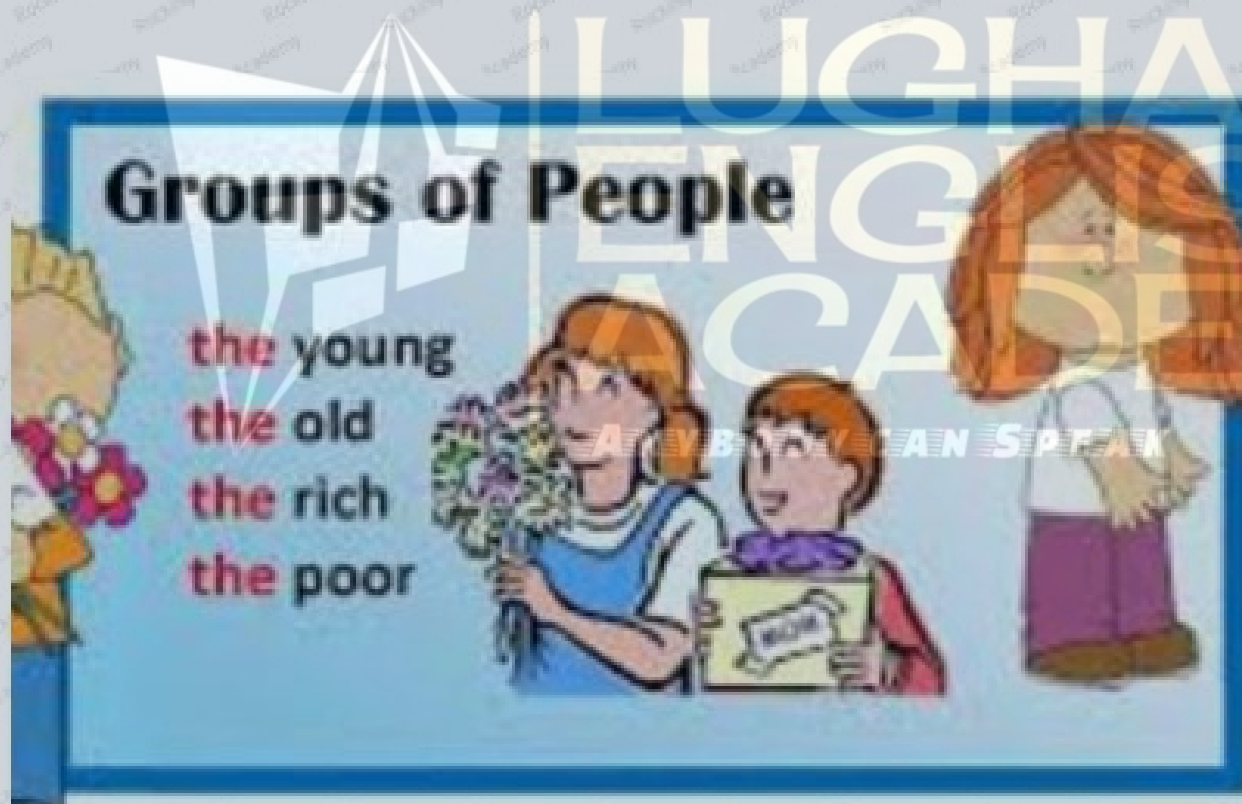
