Future	will, shall

Past continuous tense

- it refers to a continuing action or state that was happening at some point in the past.

eg: She **was talking** constantly in class in these days.

a) Sentences – past continuous

Subject	to be + verb+ing	+ object
I, He, She, It, Sam (Name)	was playing	football
You, We, They	were playing	football

Example:

- i) I was playing football.
- ii) You were playing football.
- iii) We were playing football.
- iv) They were playing football.
- v) He was playing football.
- vi) She was playing football.
- vii) It was playing football.
- viii) Sam was playing football.

b) Negative sentences – past continuous

Subject	to be + not + verb+ing	+ object
I, He, She, It, Sam (Name)	was not (wasn't) going	to school
You, We, They	were not (weren't) going	to school

Example :

i) I was going to school.	i) I was not going to school.
ii) You were going to school.	ii) You were not going to school.
iii) We were going to school.	iii) We were not going to school.
iv) They were going to school.	iv) They were not going to school.
v) He was going to school.	v) He was not going to school.
vi) She was going to school.	vi) She was not going to school.
vii) It was going to school.	vii) It was not going to school.
viii) Sam was going to school.	viii) Sam was not going to school.

c) Questions – past continuous

To be + subject	verb+ing	+ object
Was I, Was he, Was she, Was it, Was Sam (Name)	singing	song
Were you, Were we, Were they	Singing	song

Example :

i) I was singing a song.	i) Was I singing a song?
ii) You were singing a song.	ii) Were you singing a song?
iii) We were singing a song.	iii) Were we singing a song?
iv) They were singing a song.	iv) Were they singing a song?
v) He was singing a song.	v) Was he singing a song?

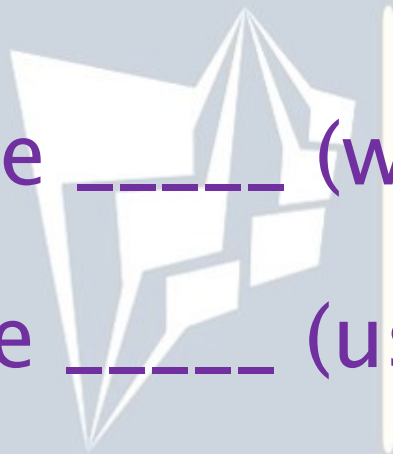

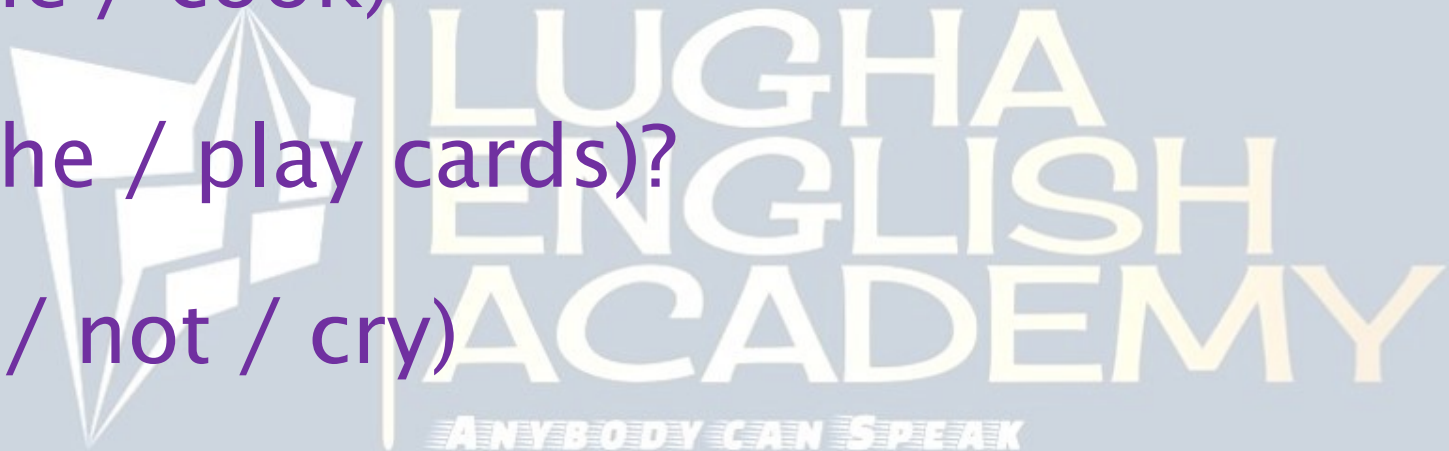
