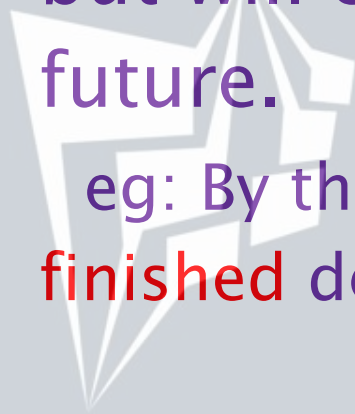
Present	am, is, are
Past	was, were
Future	will, shall
Perfect	have, has, had

Future perfect tense:

- indicates action that are completed or finished

- these actions have not yet occurred but will occur and be finished in the future.

eg: By the time you finish dinner, I **will have finished** dessert.

Second person	You	You
Third person	He, She, It, Name (ex: Sam)	They

a) Sentences – future perfect

Subject	to be + have + verb (v3)	+ object
I, We	shall have played	football
You, They, He, She, It, Sam	will have played	football

Example:

- i) I shall have played football.
- ii) We shall have played football.
- iii) You will have played football.
- iv) They will have played football.
- v) He will have played football.
- vi) She will have played football.
- vii) It will have played football.
- viii) Sam will have played football.

b) Negative sentences – future perfect

Subject	to be + not + have +verb (v3)	+ object
I, We,	shall not (shan't) have gone	to school
You, They, He, She, It, Sam	will not (won't) have gone	to school

Example :

i) I shall have gone to school.	i) I shall not have gone to school.
ii) You will have gone to school.	ii) You will not have gone to school.
iii) We shall have gone to school.	iii) We shall not have gone to school.
iv) They will have gone to school.	iv) They will not have gone to school.
v) He will have gone to school.	v) He will not have gone to school.
vi) She will have gone to school.	vi) She will not have gone to school.
vii) It will have gone to school.	vii) It will not have gone to school.
viii) Sam will have gone to school.	viii) Sam will not have gone to school.

c) Questions – future perfect

To be + subject + (have)	Verb (v3)	+ object
Shall I have, Shall we have	sung	song
Will you have, Will they have, Will he have, Will she have, Will it have	sung	song

Example :

i) I shall have sung a song.	i) Shall I have sung a song?
ii) You will have sung a song.	ii) Will you have sung a song?
iii) We shall have sung a song.	iii) Shall we have sung a song?
iv) They will have sung a song.	iv) Will they have sung a song?
v) He will have sung a song.	v) Will he have sung a song?
vi) She will have sung a song.	vi) Will she have sung a song?
vii) It will have sung a song.	vii) Will it have sung a song?
viii) Sam will have sung a song.	viii) Will Sam have sung a song?

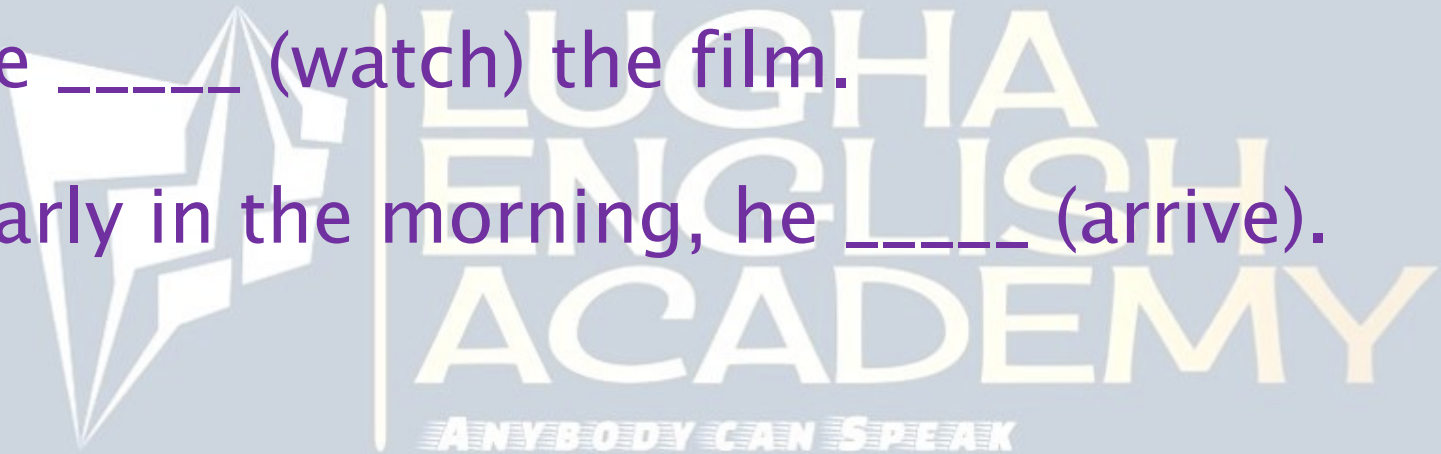

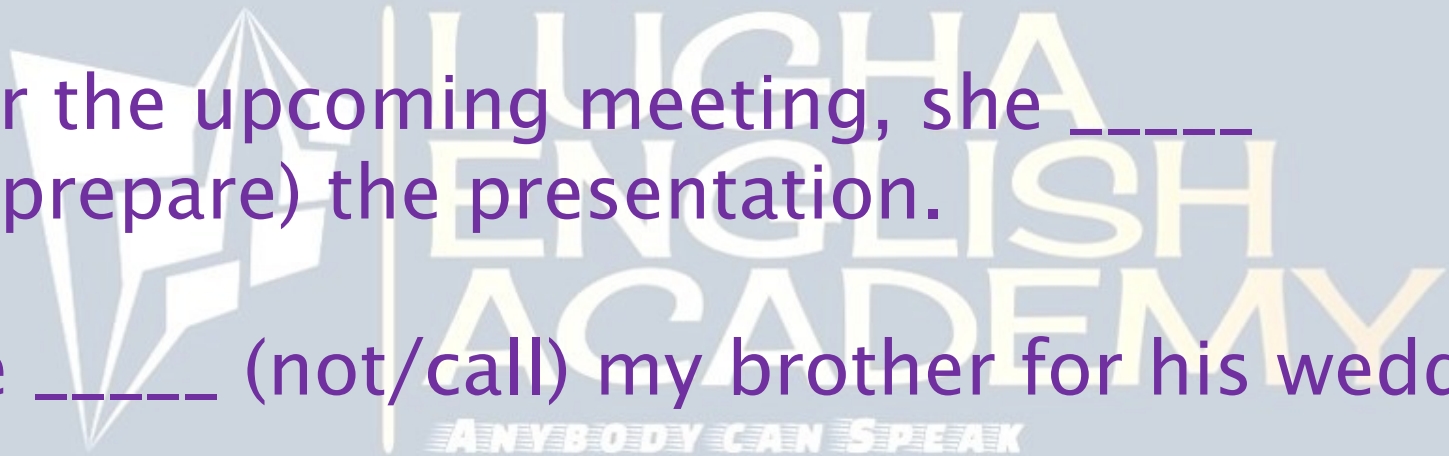
