▶ **Getting to Know Each Other**

▶ **Theme: Personal Interests & Experiences**

✓ Warm-up: "Two Truths and a Lie" - Each student shares two true statements and one false statement about themselves. Others guess the lie.

✓ Conversation Questions:

1. What is something unique about you that most people don't know?
2. If you could have dinner with any historical figure, who would it be and why?
3. What was the best trip or vacation you ever had?
4. If you had to describe yourself in three words, what would they be?
5. What is one hobby you would love to start but haven't yet?

▶ Technology & Social Media

▶ Theme: Impact of Technology on Life

☑ Warm-up: Debate - "Is social media more harmful or helpful for teenagers?"

☑ Conversation Questions:

1. How would your life be different without the internet?
2. What are the advantages and disadvantages of social media?
3. Should schools allow students to use smartphones during class? Why or why not?
4. Do you think artificial intelligence will take over jobs in the future?
5. If you could invent a new app, what would it do?

▶ Future & Ambitions

▶ Theme: Dreams, Careers & Future Plans

✓ Warm-up: "If I were the president for a day..." - Students share one change they would make.

✓ Conversation Questions:

1. What do you want to be when you grow up, and why?
2. If you could live in any country for a year, where would it be?
3. Do you believe money or happiness is more important in choosing a career? Why?
4. What is one skill you wish schools taught that isn't in the curriculum?
5. If you could time-travel to the future, what year would you visit and why?

► **Fun & Imagination**

► **Theme: Creativity & Hypothetical Scenarios**

✓ Warm-up: "What if..." Game - Give students fun "what if" scenarios to discuss.

✓ Conversation Questions:

1. If you could have any superpower, what would it be?
2. Imagine you woke up one day and everyone spoke a different language. What would you do?
3. If you were stranded on a deserted island, what three things would you bring?
4. If you could switch lives with any fictional character for a day, who would it be?
5. What would the world look like if humans could fly?

▶ Technology & Ethics Debate

▶ Objective: Develop critical thinking and argumentation skills.

✓ Warm-up: Tech in My Life - Students list the three most important technologies they use daily and explain why.

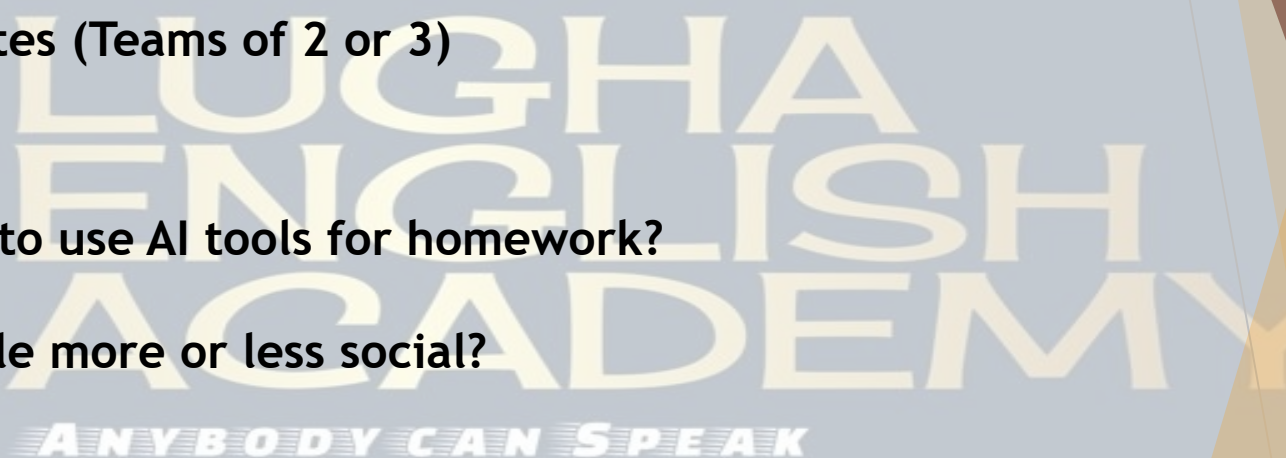
✓ Main Activity: Mini Debates (Teams of 2 or 3)

✓ Discussion Questions:

3. Would you prefer a world where robots do all the work? Why or why not?



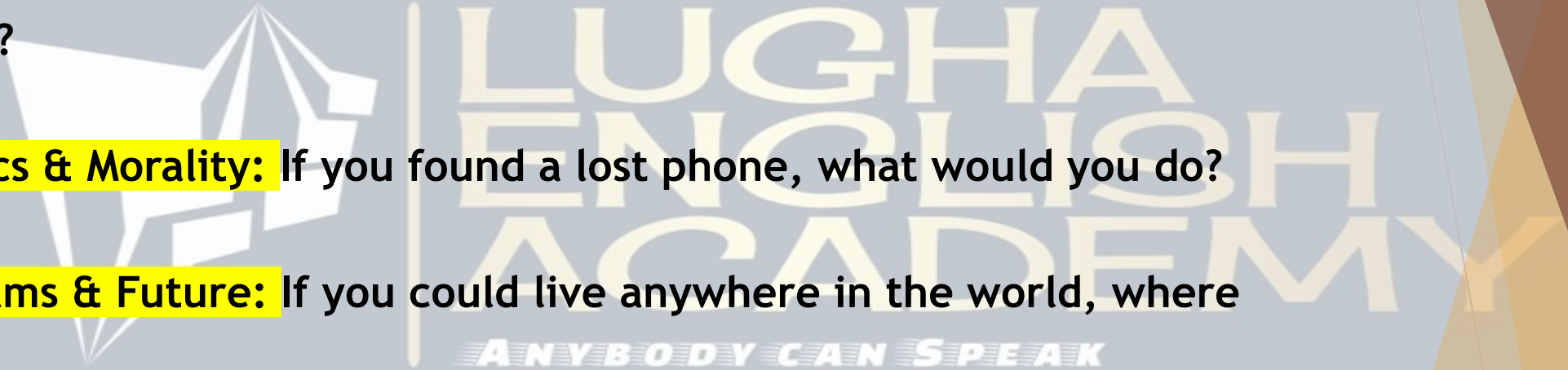
1. Personal Growth: What is one skill you've learned that you're really proud of?

2. Supernatural & Fun: If you could have one superpower for a day, what would you do with it?

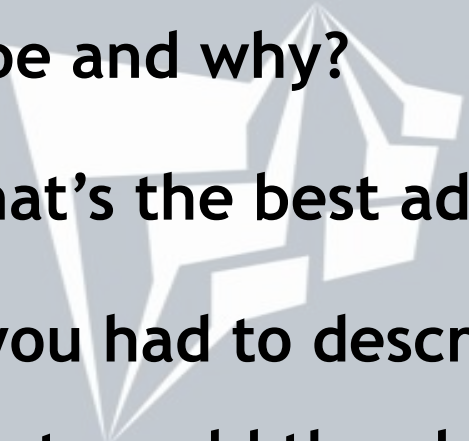
3. Society & Culture: Should students be required to do community service? Why or why not?

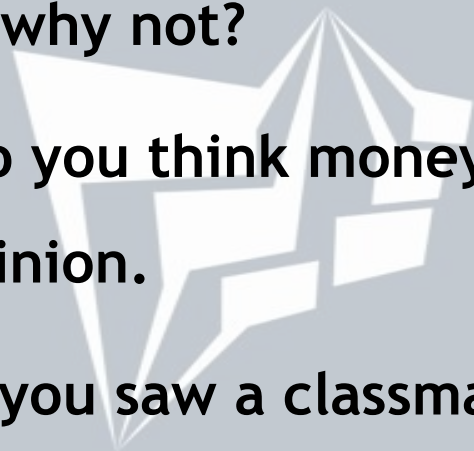
16. Is it ever okay to lie? Why or why not?
