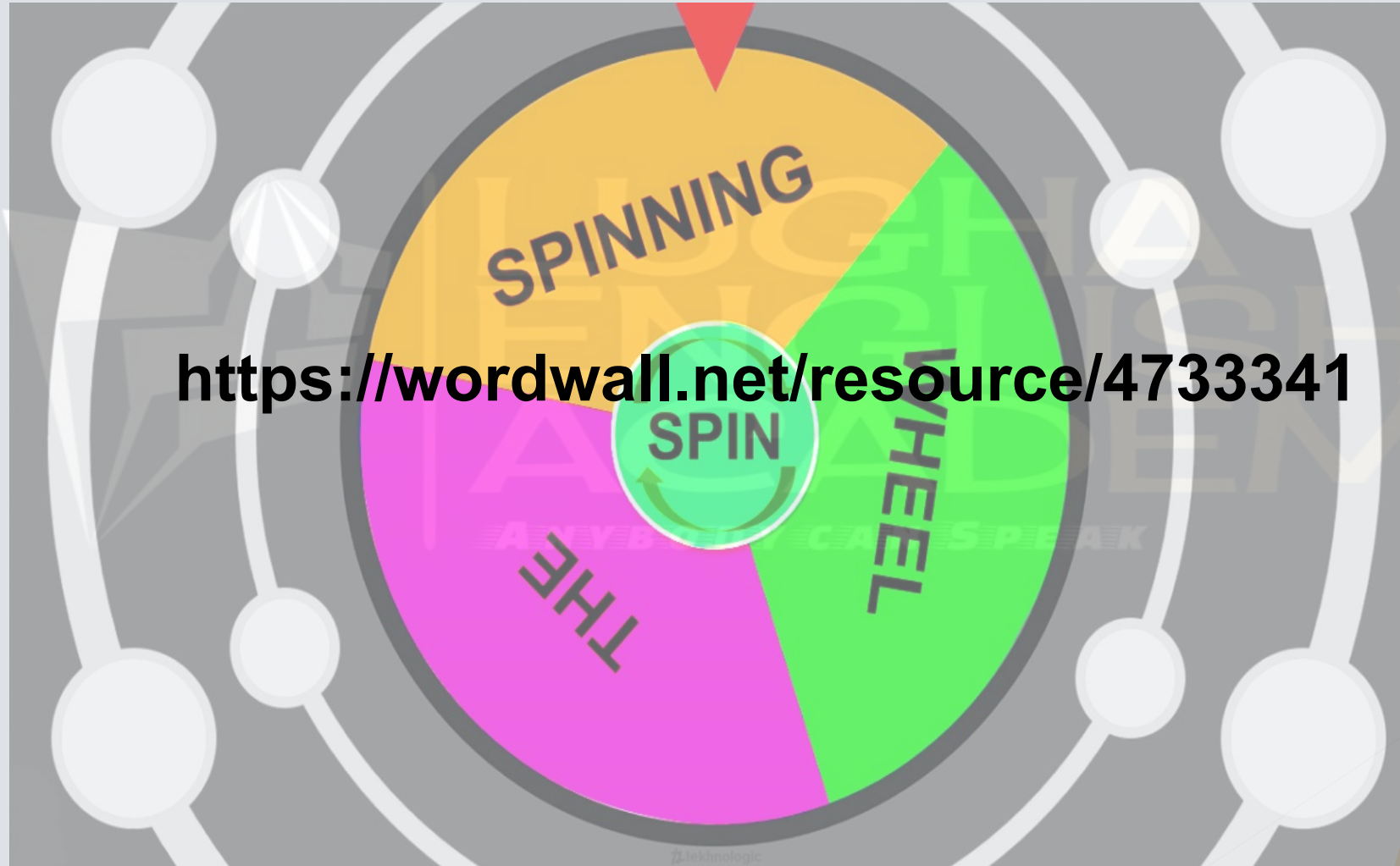

How to Play:

Each child says 3 statements — 2 truths and 1 made-up. Others guess which one is false!

Example:

- I have two cats.
- I once touched a crocodile.
- I don't like ice cream.

Why it's great: Builds confidence, listening, and curiosity!

My Dream House

How to Play:

Ask kids to describe or draw their dream house and talk about it.

Prompts:

- **Where is it located?**
- **What's in your bedroom?**
- **Does it have a slide, robot, chocolate room?**

Rainbow Talk

How to Play:

Assign a color and ask students to talk about something that's that color.

Example:

“RED – Talk about something red you love.”

(“I love strawberries because...”)



Interview a Friend

How to Play:

Pair kids up (or let one child play both roles) and give them simple interview questions.

Examples:

- **What's your favorite game?**
- **What do you like doing after school?**
- **If you had a magic pen, what would you draw?**
- **What makes you laugh the most?**
- **If you could be any animal, which one would you be and why?**
- **What's your favorite food to eat for dinner?**
- **Who is your best friend and what do you like doing together?**
- **What would you do if you found a treasure map?**

Silly Story Switch

How to Play:

Start a silly story. Each student adds one sentence.

Start with:

“Yesterday, I found a pair of flying socks in my closet...”
