



Sentence pattern

- a sentence has a subject, a verb and an object.
- a sentence has three parts.
 - a) subject
 - b) verb
 - c) object

Subject

– subject comes in the beginning of the sentence.

- a subject can be a **Noun** or **Pronoun**

- it names **whom** or **what** the sentence is about.

- a subject does the action.

Example:

Hari washed the car.

Priya is my friend.

Verb

- a complete sentence is made up of a **subject** and a **predicate**.
- a main word in a predicate is a **verb**.
- verbs are words that show what the subject **does, says, has or is**.

Example:

Grandpa **is reading** a newspaper.

Ram **is writing** a letter.

Object

- an object of the sentence comes after the verb in the predicate.
- an object can be a place / thing that receives the action of the subject.
- an object answers the question **what (things) / whom (person)**

Example:

Nicki plays **football**.

The elephant obeyed the **trainer**.
