



Sentence pattern

- the most common sentence pattern is subject and verb (SV).
- the subject comes before verb.

a) Subject

b) Verb

Subject

– subject comes in the beginning of the sentence.

- a subject can be a **Noun** or **Pronoun**

- it names **whom** or **what** the sentence is about.

- a subject does the action.

Example:

Hari is reading.

She sings.

Verb

- a verb can be an **action verb** (action done by the subject) or a **linking verb** (connects the subject of the verb)
- verbs are words that show what the subject **does, says, has or is.**

Example:

Grandpa **is listening.**

We **cooked.**
