



Adjunct or Adverbials (A)

- additional part
- a sentence can be completed without an adjunct. To add some additional information we will use adjunct.
- an adjunct answers the questions how, when, where and sometimes why
- adjuncts are optional for a sentence, even if it is removed, it will not affect the remainder of the sentence.

Example:

Birds fly **in the sky**.

She went **out**.

They waited **outside**.

Note

subject : noun / pronoun

verb : action done by the

subject

object : answers the question

what/whom

complement : after be verbs (is,

was, are, were, am)

adjunct : answers the question

how, how often, how long, where, why,
when

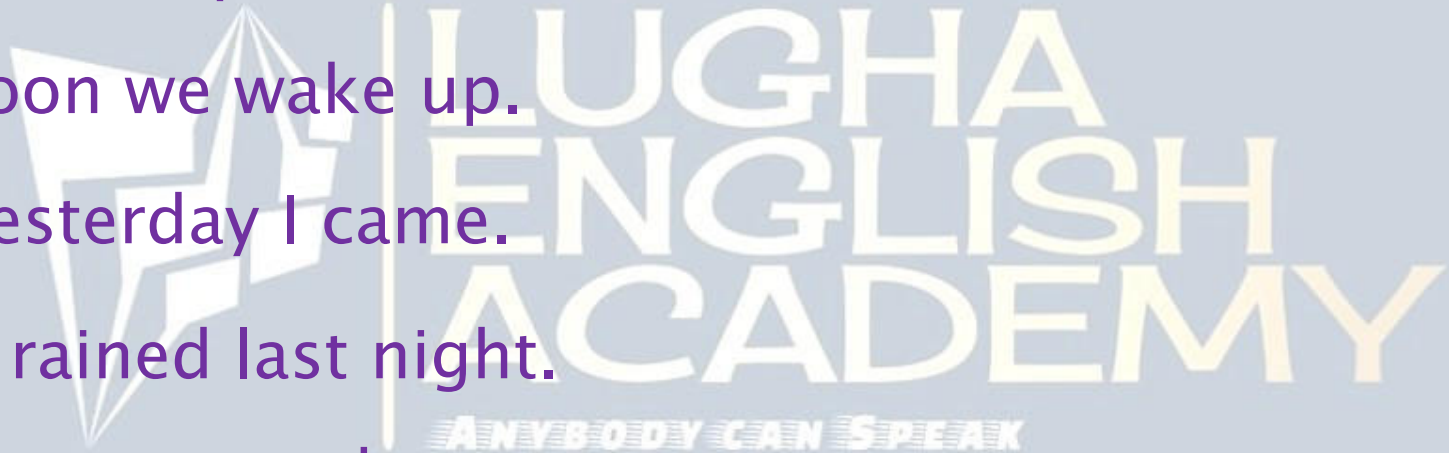

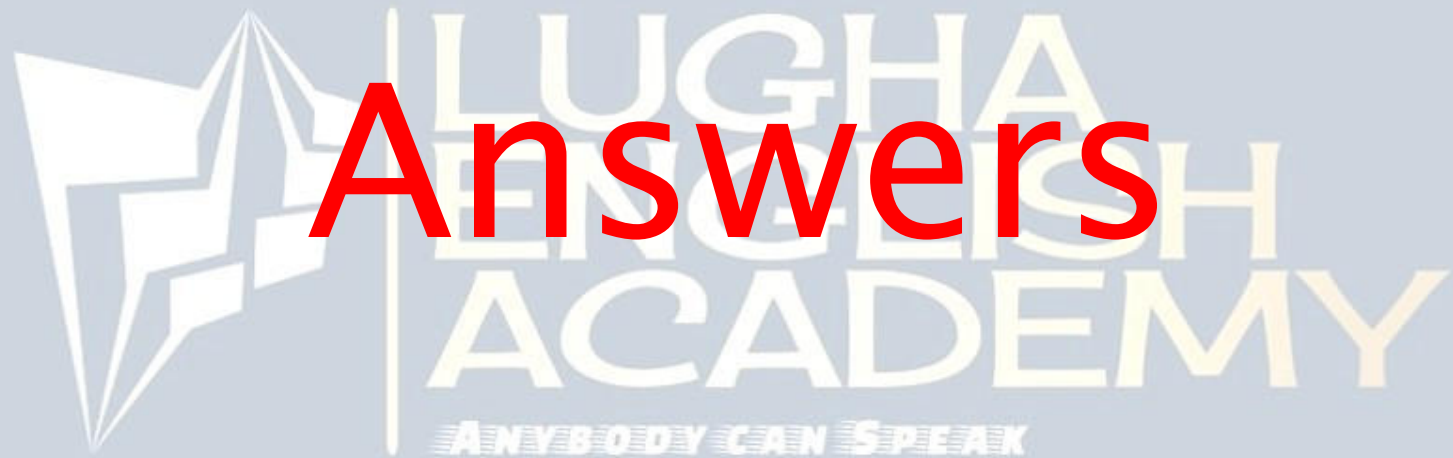

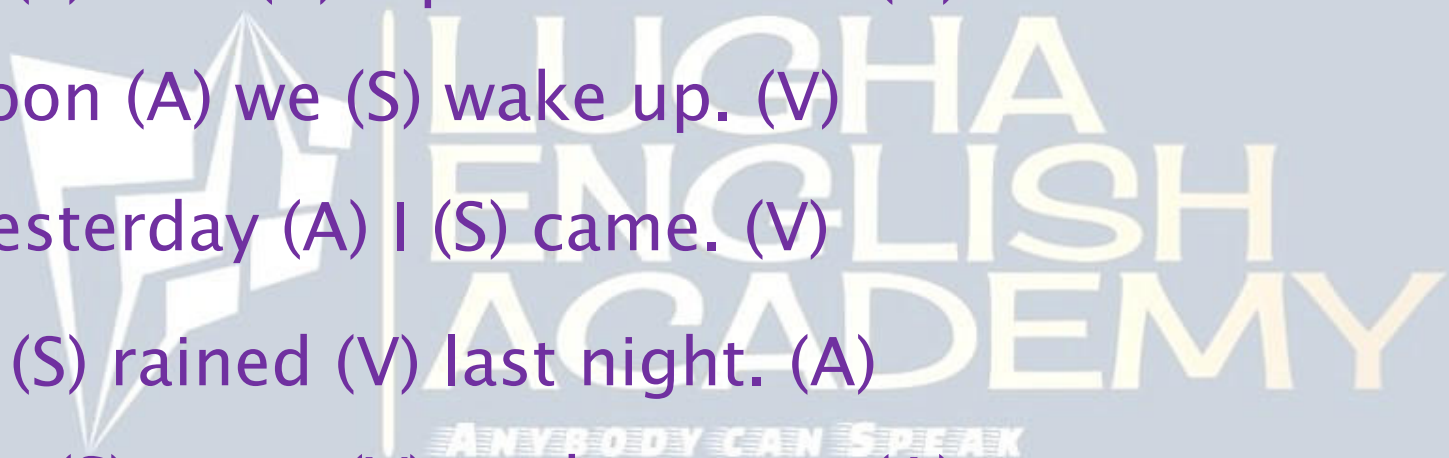
