



Indirect / Direct Object

IO – (Indirect Object) – answers whom.

DO – (Direct Object) answers the questions what.

Example:

He taught **us** (IO) English (DO).

I gave **her** (IO) my watch (DO).

She presented **me** (IO) a gift (DO).

Note:

The patterns SVOO, SVOC looks quite similar but there is a one main difference between them.

1. I gave **him** (IO) *a piece of chocolate* (DO).

2. They elected **him** (O) *president* (C).

(The object complement talks about the same person or a thing.)
