

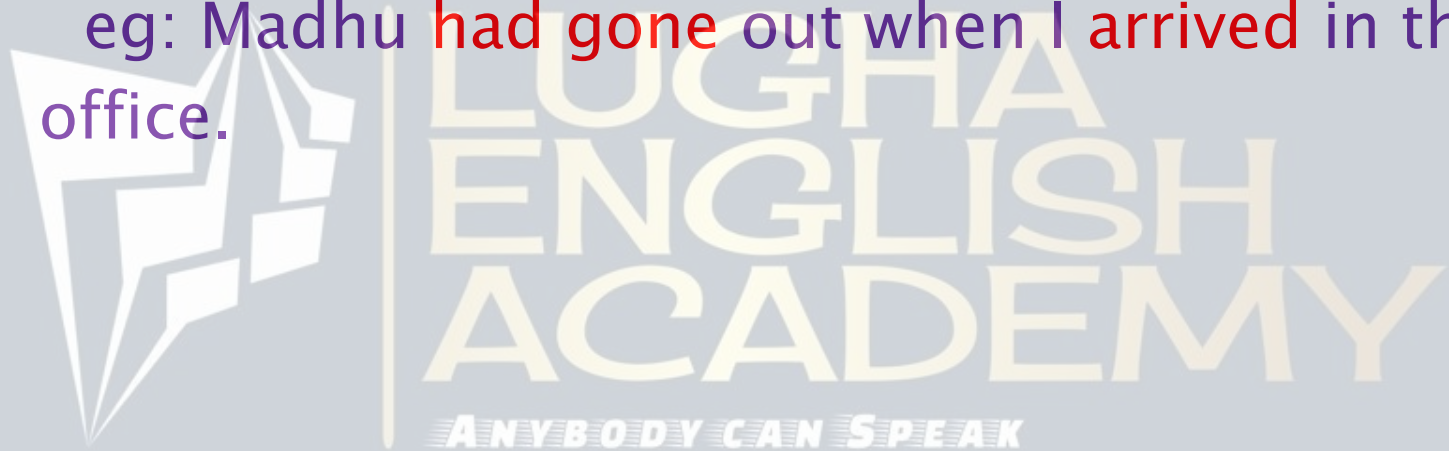
Verbs – to be

Present	am, is, are
Past	was, were
Future	will, shall
Perfect	have, has, had

Past perfect tense

- refers to a time earlier than before now.
- It is used to make it clear that one event happened before another in the past.

eg: Madhu **had gone** out when I **arrived** in the office.

Subject	singular	Plura
	<i>ANYBODY CAN SPEAK</i>	I
First person	I	We
Second person	You	You
Third person	He, She, It, Name (ex: Sam)	They

a) Sentences – past perfect

Subject	to be (had)+verb (v3)	+ object
I, You, We, They, He, She, It, Sam	had played	football

Example:

- i) I had played football.
- ii) You had played football.
- iii) We had played football.
- iv) They had played football.
- v) He had played football.
- vi) She had played football.
- vii) It had played football.
- viii) Sam had played football.

b) Negative sentences – past perfect

Subject	to be (had) + not +verb (v3)	+ object
I, You, We, They, He, She, It, Sam	had not (hadn't) gone	to school

Example :

i) I had gone to school.	i) I had not gone to school.
ii) You had gone to school.	ii) You had not gone to school.
iii) We had gone to school.	iii) We had not gone to school.
iv) They had gone to school.	iv) They had not gone to school.
v) He had gone to school.	v) He had not gone to school.
vi) She had gone to school.	vi) She had not gone to school.
vii) It had gone to school.	vii) It had not gone to school.
viii) Sam had gone to school.	viii) Sam had not gone to school.

c) Questions – present perfect

To be (had) + subject	Verb (v3)	+ object
Had I, Had you, Had we, Had they	sung	song
Had he, Had she, Had it	sung	song

Example :

i) I had sung a song.	i) had I sung a song?
ii) You had sung a song.	ii) had you sung a song?
iii) We had sung a song.	iii) had we sung a song?
iv) They had sung a song.	iv) had they sung a song?
v) He had sung a song.	v) had he sung a song?
vi) She had sung a song.	vi) had she sung a song?
vii) It had sung a song.	vii) had it sung a song?
viii) Sam had sung a song.	viii) had Sam sung a song?

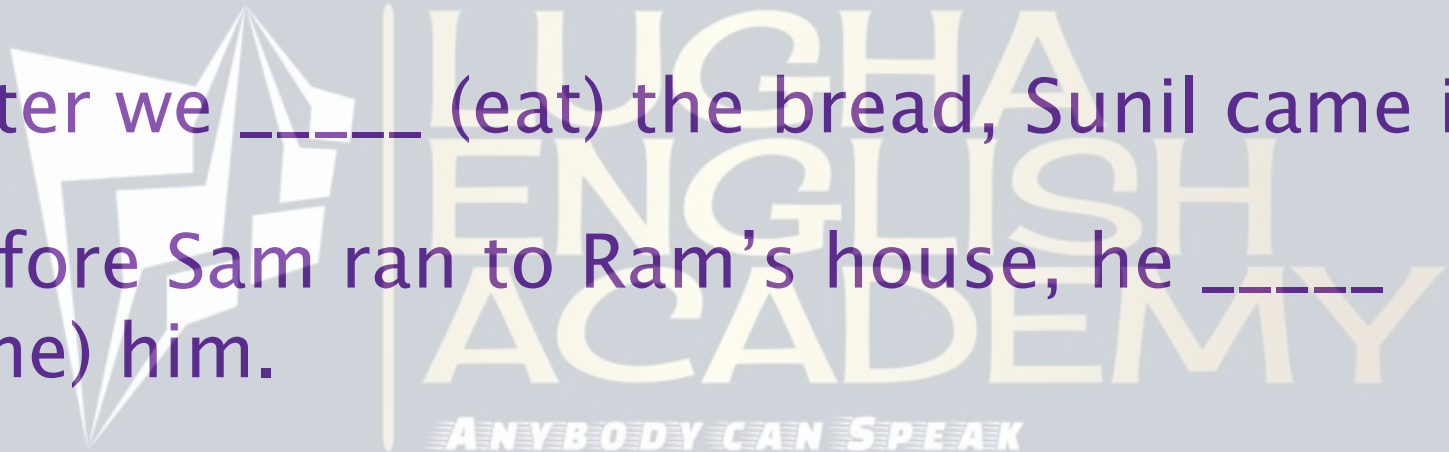
