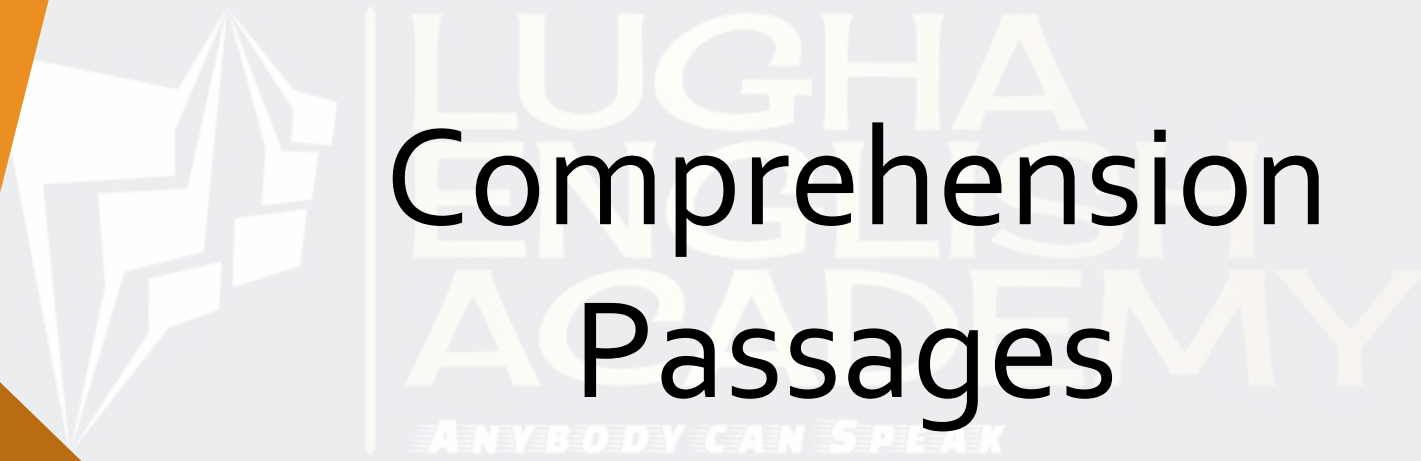




Comprehension Passages
