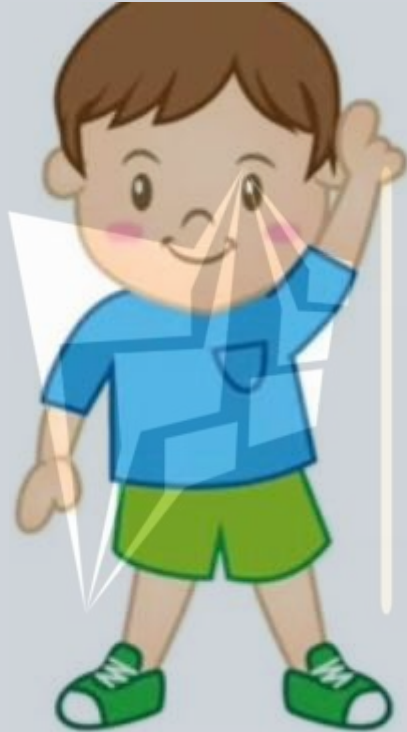

Types of Adverbs

ANYBODY CAN SPEAK





An **Adverb** is a word that modifies Verb or an Adjective.

It tells something more about a Verb.

Adverb Examples



In this example **Ram** is a **Noun** and the word **running** is a **Verb**.

The word **"QUICKLY"** is an **Adverb**. It tells more about the **Verb running**.

Ram is running **quickly**

Adverb Examples

In this example **Lion** is a **Noun**
and the word **roars** is a **Verb**.

The word **"LOUDLY"** is an
Adverb, it tells more about the
Verb roars.

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The Lion roars **loudly**.

Adverb

ALWAYS REMEMBER

An **ADVERB** never describes
a **NOUN** or a **PRONOUN**.

It describes a **VERB** or an
ADJECTIVE.



Adverb

An **ADVERB** tells “**HOW**”, “**WHERE**” or “**WHEN**” an action happened.



Adverb Examples

Priya is running quickly.

Priya – noun

run – verb

quickly – adverb (tells more about a

verb)

Lion roars loudly.

Lion – noun

roars – verb

loudly – adverb (tells more about a verb)

Note : An adverb never describes a noun or a pronoun. It describes a verb or an adjective.

Adverb – adding “ly”

Most ADVERB can be made by adding “ly” to an ADJECTIVE or VERB .

Example:- The dress is elegant.

Here elegant is an Adjective which describes the Noun dress.

She dresses elegantly.

Here elegantly is an Adverb that describes the Verb dresses.

Some More Examples:

QUICK + LY = QUICKLY

SLOW + LY = SLOWLY

BRIGHT + LY = BRIGHTLY
